Due to the geographical situations, we will have two meet up points. Those in southern New England will converge in the parking lot of the Crowne Plaza in Nashua NH. It is right of Exit 8 off of Rte 3 in Nashua. You can't miss it.

Directions to the Gretch compound can be are From Rte 93:

- 1. Take **exit 27** of 93 to Blair Bridge (US-3)/W. Campton go 0.4 mi
- 2. Turn right at Blair Rd go 390 ft
- 3. Turn **left at Daniel Webster Hwy** go 2.6 mi
- 4. Turn left at Old Daniel Webster Rd - go 0.2 mi
- 5. Turn left at Ellsworth Hill Rd go 1.5 mi
- 6. Turn left at Mason Rd go 0.6 mi End at # 176

Meet up time on the Southern end is at ~11:00 AM, first one there grab a spot, preferably close to the pond.

Meet up at the Northern End (Gretch's) will be at ~12:30, the southern gathering will head up ~12:45. Once the southern group reaches Campton we'll organize, relax for an hour or so, check fluids, and plan for the run.

We'll plan a run around the White Mountains that should last for approx. an hour and a half to two hours, depending on weather, group preference etc.

We'll end the run at the Common Man inn, in Plymouth NH. For a few amber colored adult beverages, and food for those that so choose.



All are welcome, Having a Porsche is not a requirement for entry. Those that show up with Dodge Colt Vistas however will be taunted mercilessly. Please feel free to pass this flyer around to any that you think might like to attend. There is of course no fee for this event, al expenses for food and beverage are your own responsibility, some drinks may be provided.
